Service programme for Persons with Intellectual Disability and Homeless Mentally Ill in Odisha:

In the year 1984, while teaching Courses on Intellectual Disability, I found that there was no Service Programme or Special School for the Children with Intellectual Disability in Odisha State. Then I discussed the matter with some of my colleagues in the Department and friends in the city. With the objective to organize Service Programmes for the children with Intellectual Disability, a meeting was convened in the Department of Psychology, where all these people attended and decided to start a Special School for the Children with Intellectual Disability in Bhubaneswar. Late Santosh Kumar Sahoo, the then Member of Parliament, was elected as the President, and I was elected as the General Secretary of the Organization.

In June 1986, a School for Children with Intellectual Disability named as "Chetana" was started. The school was recognized by the then CD & RR Department, Govt. of Odisha. In the year 1989, Chetana was recognized by the National Institute for the Mentally Handicapped, Secunderabad, as a Training Centre for the Teachers of Mentally Handicapped. The Teachers Training Centre also has been recognized by the Women and Child Development Department, Government of Odisha, Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi (the Rehabilitation Council of India is the Statutory Body under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, to regulate the Teaching Programmes in the field of Disability).

At present, Chetana has three Special Schools for Children with Intellectual Disability at Bhubaneswar, Balakati, and Bhawanipatna, and a Vocational Training Centre for adults with Intellectual Disability at Damapada in Cuttack District.

The Organization has started the Chetana College of Special Education which runs Diploma, B.Ed., and M.Ed. Special Education, Intellectual Disability and M.A. in Applied Psychology Programmes.

It has also started Rehabilitation Programme for the Homeless Mentally Ill from the year 2022 at Damapada.

The Institute has three campuses at Bhubaneswar, Balakati and Damapada having building of about 100,000 square feet.

In addition to these, the Institute also conducts Seminars, Workshops, and Training Programmes for Doctors, Administrative Officers, Parents, Special Educators, Social Workers, ICDS Functionaries, and School Teachers on Intellectual Disability.

As a result of the Activities of the Organization, thousands of Families of children with Intellectual Disability and other disabilities all over the State have been benefited. Several Special Schools have come up under the technical cooperation of this Institute.
